

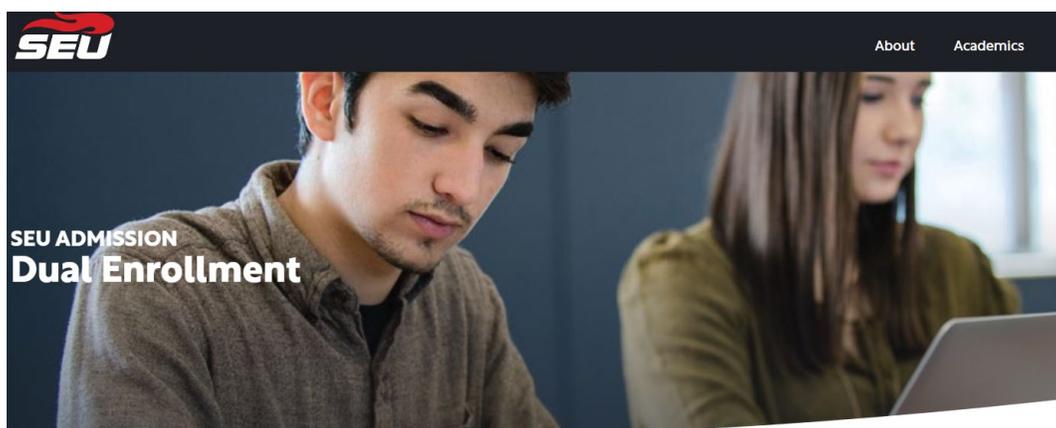
Registering for Early SEU Dual Enrollment Classes

Thank you for choosing to do Early SEU courses through Southeastern University's Ohio regional campus. For each semester in which you take Early SEU classes, you will need to apply to the Early SEU program. Early SEU students can take online classes from anywhere in Ohio as well as face-to-face classes at our Columbus campus. A Zoom option is also available for most SEU Ohio classes.

The instructions below will help you select the right options to apply for Early SEU classes at SEU Ohio.

OVERVIEW

- Online courses are 8 weeks long and students may complete the weekly assignments on their own schedules.
- Face-to-face classes are also 8 weeks long.
- Dual enrollment is open to high school sophomores, juniors, and seniors with at least a 3.0 GPA. No tests or transcripts are required.
- Online courses are offered each semester during the fall, spring, and summer.

- **Apply to SEU.**
- Take the **Placement Exam** (if required by your state).
- Check your personal email for enrollment confirmation and next steps.
- Email dualenrollment@seu.edu with any questions.
